

MAYET 2 STAR CAMPSITE CAMPING RULES 2023 SEASON

- Open from April 28th until October 15th under temporary surveillance.
- Closed from October 15th except special permission granted by the mairie (local authority in Mayet) for seasonal workers.
- Outside of the reception desk's opening hours, campers must contact the local officer on duty (see emergency phone numbers listed on the call-out sheet).

2) ENTRANCE CONDITIONS

Before entering the campsite and pitching your tent or parking your caravan, please request permission from the campsite administrator. You will be given an access code.

Two-axled caravans are not permitted. Permanent travellers are not allowed as there is a specific site open for them in VAAS and AUBIGNE-RACAN.

Staying at the Mayet campsite means that you accept our camping rules and abide by them.

In case of violation of the rules, the campsite administrator may ask you to leave and call the police if necessary.

3) PITCHING UP / PARKING

Tents, caravans, campervans and any other equipement must be placed <u>on a designated camping pitch</u>, in accordance with the <u>instructions given by the campsite administrator</u>. Please <u>do not move</u> any of your equipment <u>without being given authorisation to do so.</u>

On arrival, campers must present their proof of identity and an insurance certificate. If you own a 2nd-category dog, you must provide a licence.

Our campsite opens and closes with an automatic gate activated by a badge. You will be given a badge on arrival by paying a 20€ deposit. You will get your deposit back on returning the badge.

4) **FEES**

Payment takes place at the reception desk.

Our rates apply per number of nights spent at our campsite.

Using a caravan parked on a long term unoccupied pitch for a day will automatically involve having to pay our daily rates, even if you do not stay overnight at the campsite.

Should you leave after 12pm, you will have to pay for an extra daily fee.

Please notify the reception desk the day before you plan to leave.

Campers leaving before the reception desk's opening hours must pay their fees the day before and give the badge back.

5) TOURIST TAX

From the 1st January to the 31st December, all visitors over 13 years of age have to pay a 0.22€ tourist tax per day and per person.

6) PEACE AND QUIET

All campers are urgently requested to avoid excessive noise and loud conversations that might disturb other campers.

Please make sure the volume of all sound equipment is kept to a reasonable level and do not slam doors.

Dogs and other pets are not permitted to walk freely on the campsite, nor are they allowed to stay unattended in their owner's car, caravan or tent. Owners must present their pet's vaccination book.

Pets should be kept on a lead.

They are not allowed to use the campsite as a toilet. Should an accident occur, the owner is responsible for cleaning up.

ABSOLUTE QUIET IS MANDATORY BETWEEN 10 PM and 7 AM

7) VISITORS

Visitors (family or friends) are allowed at the campsite under the responsibility of the camper they visit. <u>Visitors' cars must be parked outside the camping site.</u>

Walkers can access the lake up to 10pm and afterwards providing they keep completely silent and respect the environment.

The same rules apply for accessing our reception desk.

Any vehicule owner parked overnight (from 10pm to 7am) on our car park must pay the camping fee.

8) DRIVING AND PARKING ON THE CAMPSITE

Vehicules must drive dead slow within the enclosure of the campsite.

No traffic is allowed between 10pm and 7am.

Only the campers vehicules are allowed on the campsite (work vehicules are not allowed). Only campers are allowed to park their car, caravan, campervan and pitch a tent. It is not allowed to impede traffic or to prevent new arrivals from pitching.

Please put your tent, caravan or campervan within the pitch allocated to you.

9) CAMPING ENVIRONMENT

A mains drainage system is provided free of charge for campervans on the condition that they stay on a designated area on the campsite.

Do not do anything that might spoil the neatness, hygiene or appearance of the campsite.

It is not allowed to dump polluted water anywhere on the campsite.

Campers must dispose of dirty water in the designated facilities only.

Please dispose of all rubbish, glass, paper and plastic in the designated containers.

Please use your own bin bags and recycle as per our instructions.

Washing is only permitted in the designated sinks. Car washing is forbidden.

Campers must not damage trees, cut branches or plant anything.

Please stay withing your designated pitch, do not try to make it bigger using your own equipment. Do not dig holes and light fires.

Individual barbecues are permitted. Please dispose of the ash and leave the place neat and tidy.

Anyone causing damage to our trees, plants, shrubs, fences or camping facilities will face financial penalties.

10) SAFETY

A fire extinguisher is available outside the toilets.

In case of fire, please dial 112.

In case of an emergency, please dial 15.

THEFT: Each camper is responsible for their own possessions. The management cannot be held responsible for theft or damages to any property belonging to campers.

11) **GAMES**

It is not allowed to play wild, boisterous games that might disturb other campers. We offer a designated playground, please respect the age limitations when using the playground equipment.

Anyone can use the playground equipment even if not staying at the campsite, providing they respect the age limitations and do not disturb the campers or the camping facilities.

12) LONG TERM UNOCCUPIED PITCH

Unoccupied equipment (caravans or campervans) can only be allowed to stay on a designated pitch by the campsite management. Long term unoccupied pitching will be charged at the rate displayed on our board.

13) CAMPERS PEACE

In order to ensure our campers' peace and quiet, we have fitted an automated gate that can only be opened with the badge given to you by the campsite administrator.

14) COVID 19

- Hand sanitiser gel is at your disposal
- We regularly clean taps and door handles
- Please use the pedal bins provided in the toilets
- Please use the paper towels at your disposal
- Please read all the signs
- We recommend 10 people maximum on the playground
